Jensen, and the award bestowed in his name honors current RMD members who exemplify Jay's standard of exceptional service and dedication to both the identification sciences and to the Rocky Mountain Division. With this definition in mind, it is our honor to nominate Mr. Jan LeMay for the Jay R. Jensen award.

Jan's efforts in advancing knowledge and professionalism in several branches of the identification sciences is unparalleled by any current RMD member. In his twenty-plus career with the Weld County Sheriff's Department Jan as served as a crime scene investigator, fingerprint and footwear examiner, and teacher. He is author of the textbook *Crime Scene Investigation for the First Responder*, co-author of the *Journal of Forensic Identification* article "Validation of Vinyl Static Cling Film for the Collection and Preservation of Dust Impressions" that introduced this now standard footwear collection practice, as well as author or co-author of six additional JFI articles relating to footwear and tire impression evidence.

Jan's service to both the IAI and the Rocky Mountain Division is equally impressive. Jan served on the Board of Directors before becoming RMD President in 2007, and represented the Division as Regional Representative to the parent body from 2012 to 2015. Jan also served on the RMD Regional Photography Committee from 2008 to 2014 (Chair 2008 to 2012).

Jan's service is not confined to the Division. Jan has been active in the International Association for Identification, serving on the Footwear/Tiretrack Certification Board (2011 to 2014), and Jan is currently serving his second term on the Board of Directors.

We trust you will look upon this exemplary record of public service, scientific research, and dedication to both the IAI and Rocky Mountain Division with favor and confer upon Jan LeMay the Jay R. Jensen Award he so richly deserves.
